

OSHA Coating Compliance Checklist

A pre-project safety & compliance checklist for commercial and industrial coating work

General-guidance checklist — verify against current OSHA standards and your site's safety plan. Not a substitute for a qualified safety professional.

Before mobilization

- ☐ Written job hazard analysis (JHA) completed for each task
- ☐ SDS on file for every coating, solvent, and surface-prep media
- ☐ Hazard Communication labeling and worker training verified
- ☐ Contractor licensing and certificate of insurance confirmed

Respiratory & ventilation

- ☐ Respiratory protection program in place; fit-testing current
- ☐ Air monitoring planned for solvents / isocyanates where applicable
- ☐ Mechanical ventilation / extraction for enclosed spaces

Confined space (if applicable)

- ☐ Permit-required confined space program (29 CFR 1910.146)
- ☐ Atmospheric testing, attendant, and rescue plan in place

Fall protection & access

- ☐ Fall protection above threshold height; equipment inspected
- ☐ Scaffold / aerial lift inspected and operators trained

Fire, hazmat & site control

- ☐ Flammable/combustible storage and ignition controls
- ☐ Combustible-dust controls for abrasive blasting
- ☐ Hazardous waste handling and disposal plan
- ☐ Signage, barricades, and occupant notification posted
